What's Included

3 20-Minute Sessions of Your Choice

Each dog will enjoy a multitude of enrichment session options, from reinforcing commands to playtime with a staff member!

Cozy Canine Room

Between sessions, pups will relax by lounging in their own 3' x 4' room or 48" crate with a water bucket, & any comfy touches you'd like to bring from home.

Report Card

Enrichment dogs will get a report card describing their day's activities FREE with each visit!

Enrichment sessions are customizable to each dog's specific needs! If there are any activities your dog might enjoy, or any specific behaviors you would like us to work on, please don't hesitate to ask.

What are the benefits of Enrichment Days?

Dogs need a minimum of 20 minutes of enrichment a day in order to maintain their physical & mental health. Dogs who are not getting their enrichment needs met often resort to inappropriate behaviors. Enrichment Days are designed to not just meet, but exceed, your dog's enrichment needs so you can check off that item on your busy to-do list. Dogs whose enrichment needs are met are happier, calmer, more well-adjusted & open to new experiences, & often show a reduction in undesirable behaviors.

Availability & Cost

Enrichment days are available Monday-Friday every week, not including holidays.

- Drop-off window: 6:30 am-9:30 am
- Pick-up window: 4 pm-6:30 pm

Enrichment Days are \$45/day.

Enrichment Styles

Did you know that there are different styles of enrichment? We offer 4 regimens to meet the needs of a variety of different personalities. Ask which best fits your dog, or mix & match for a true boutique experience!

Rowdy Rover

Catered to: High-energy, high-intelligence dogs who may vent excess energy by barking, digging, or destructive behaviors.

May include: Doggie "jobs" such as basic agility, sniffing enrichment, & leashed walks.

Nervous Nelly

Catered to: Nervous nellies who experience separation anxiety, fearful reactions towards certain stimuli, or nerves related to aging.

May include: Safe introductions to a variety of people, friendly dogs, & objects.

Growing Paws

Catered to: Little ones finding their way around the world!

May include: Introduction to a variety of stimuli, such as people, friendly dogs & cats, new sounds, & handling designed to help prepare for future grooming.

Golden Years

Catered to: Old friends in their golden years seeking to avoid "shrinking world syndrome".

May include: Gentle mobility walks, balance exercises, brain stimulation, & pool time for joint health.

Requirements & Recommendations

Proof of a current rabies vaccine is required for all dogs, unless medically exempt. Bordetella & Distemper vaccines as well as flea & tick prevention are recommended as dogs will spend plenty of time outside. Both altered & unaltered dogs are welcome. Enrichment days are not intended for puppies younger than 16 weeks.
